The Washington State Legislation and the Governor signed into Law ESSB 5236 which allows parents of newborn (less than 72 hours old) children to transfer such children to Fire Stations without charges of abandonment.

The personnel of Grant County Fire District #3 are qualified to accept your newborn. These individuals will notify the necessary agencies in regard to your child.
